Behavior in First Grade

In first grade, students keep track of their behavior on rainbow charts. All students start the day on the green Ready to Learn section. Students move up or down throughout the day depending on their behavior choices. Look for the color filled in on your child's Daily News each day. This indicates where he/she ended the day.

To encourage positive class choices, we also have a special clip which is moved up or down on our class rainbow chart. The class goal is to follow our four rules: raise your hand to speak, make smart choices, follow directions quickly, and be kind. When the class ends the day on green or higher, they earn stars toward a special reward or privilege.

Think About It	Given a reminder, but has not made smart choices. Student is encouraged to think about it and get back on track. Can move back up to green if behavior changes.
Teacher's Choice	Continued to make poor choices even after reminders. Consequences are given (loss of privilege, recess minutes, etc.), but student can move back up if behavior changes.
Parent Contact	If the poor choices continue, student fills out a behavior form which is sent home. Parents and Mrs. Reagan are contacted.
