

## Prompts to Use When a Reader is Stuck

Prompts for meaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Did that make sense?</li><li>• Can the picture help you?</li><li>• What do you think it might be?</li></ul>
Prompts for syntax (sound)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Did that word sound right?</li><li>• How would we say that if we were talking?</li></ul>
Prompts for visual information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Does that look right?</li><li>• What sound does the word start with?</li><li>• What sounds do you see at the beginning, middle, and end of that word?</li><li>• Do you see a chunk that you know in that word?</li><li>• Are you looking carefully at the letters</li></ul>
Prompts for self-monitoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Try that again and use your reading finger.</li><li>• Check that word. Were you right?</li></ul>
Prompts for self-correcting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Point to the tricky part. What do you see that can help you?</li><li>• Are you right about _____? Could it be _____?</li><li>• Take a closer look at that word.</li><li>• Did you check the middle of the word?</li><li>• The word _____ would make sense, but look at _____.</li></ul>
