What is a BYSTANDER?

A bystander is someone who watches rough play or watches kids using mean words.

By watching and not helping, a bystander supports the bully.

Be an UPSTANDER.

Not a bystander.

At Georgetown, you want you to BE... ... a friend not an enemy.

.... someone who plays nice, NOT rough.

... a buddy not a bully.

... an UPSTANDER -- NOT a bystander.

What is an UPSTANDER?

It's someone who...

Stands UP for the person who is being treated badly or bullied. Does not do rough play.

Speaks Up

- "Stop. We don't treat people that way."
- Let's get out of here"
- Report it. Find an adult.

Teams UP

- ☐ Join the group.
- Yell Stop.
- Get help.

What is ROUGH PLAY?

It starts off fun, but then gets rough.

It starts off fun, but then hurtful words are said.

It starts off fun, but then rules are broken.

If rough play goes on for too long,

people get hurt.

If someone is being mean or rough to you...

Stand UP for yourself.

- Knock it off!
- Cut it out!
- Quit it!
- We don't do that here.

If words do not work, tell an adult!

When you tell an adult, they will ask...

- 1. WHO did it.
- 2. WHAT happened.
- 3. WHERE it happened.
- 4. WHY or HOW it got started.
- 5. UPSTANDERS: Did anyone else try to help?

Your behavior on the bus matters.
